## Check Out Our Recent Events

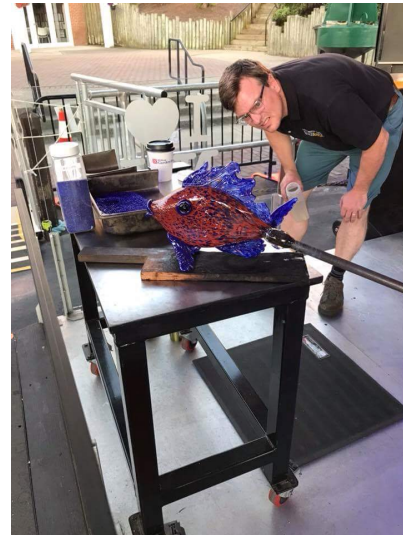

The **Corning Museum of Glass Barge** had a stop in Fairport on July 20-22. During it's stay they gave multiple demonstrations daily.

The history behind the reason for this journey is that 150 years ago (1868) the Brooklyn Flint Glass Company used the New York Waterways to relocate to Corning.

The commemorative voyage started earlier this year in May at the Brooklyn Bridge Park then traveled north on the Hudson and westward on the Erie Canal making its way to the Finger Lakes. The last leg of their trip will take place on land concluding in Corning for a community wide celebration.

The CMOG is excited to be sharing the story of glassmaking in it's Glass Barge tour and be the signature event for the statewide celebration of the Erie Canal Bicentennial. During this celebration the Glass Barge is helping to represent the continued role New York's waterways has in shaping our culture, community and industry.



The **Lois McClure** joined the tour of the Corning Glass Barge as it represents the wooden canal boats that helped move the Brooklyn Flint Glass Company to Corning. At every port the Lois McClure's crew of on-water experts, historians and archaeologists welcomed visitors.

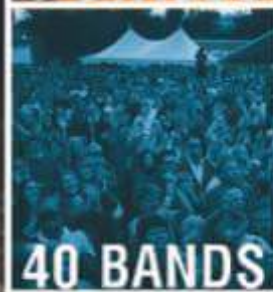
